

ConocoPhillips Grant Program 2017 Request for Proposals

Playa Lakes Joint Venture (PLJV) Mission: To conserve the playas, prairies and landscapes of the western Great Plains through partnerships for the benefit of birds, other wildlife and people.

PLJV announces the availability of funding for projects that address the PLJV mission within the Joint Venture's boundaries. The PLJV supports and promotes habitat conservation for wintering, migrating and breeding birds in portions of Colorado, Kansas, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas (see http://pljv.org/conocophillips-grants for map).

Funding is available for proposals in three categories — habitat conservation, research, and outreach — with the majority of the funding dedicated to habitat conservation projects. Funding is limited to no more than \$25,000 per project. Proposals must have a minimum of a 1:1 match, with preference given to projects that have higher levels of matching funds, and must show support and involvement from state wildlife agencies and how the project fits with PLJV priorities. Projects selected are funded on a reimbursement basis, with all funds to be spent by Dec. 1, 2017.
